CPEC 2.0: full speed ahead

CPEC-watchers see the launch of two hydel power projects in quick succession in Azad Kashmir and a special economic zone (SEZ) in Faisalabad this month as early signs of the rejuvenation of the multi-billion-dollar programme. To remove roadblocks and ensure timely progress, the government is also working on the CPEC Authority Bill 2020 that will further empower the dedicated authority created last year.

There might be some glitches here and there, but broadly the work on the first phase progressed smoothly

Remarkable success has been achieved in the CPEC development. It is mainly manifested in three aspects

- 1. The governments and enterprises of China and Pakistan are very satisfied with the progress,
- PM Imran Khan said recently that the corridor is an excellent project for Pakistan's economic and social development.
- 3. 90% of the 22 major projects have been completed and put into operation.

BOI MOVES TO SET UP SOLAR CAPTIVE PLANT FOR SEZS

The Board of Investment (BOI) has played an active role to facilitate the establishment of first ever BOLT model based- 700 megawatts (MW) solar captive power plant to provide uninterrupted energy to the FIEDMC CPEC SEZs namely M3-Industrial City and Allama Iqbal Industrial City (AIIC). It will be completed in three phases.

CHINESE PERCEPTION ON CPEC

CPEC reinvigorated

According to latest statistics of CPEC Authority (July, 2020), Chinese investment in the country in different projects of the CPEC surpassed over **\$11 billion** during 2020.

The two countries signed projects worth of \$11bn, including a \$3.9bn hydroelectric dam and a \$7.2bn railway upgradation. It is the second biggest amount of Chinese investment in a single year after 2015 which witnessed a total investment of over \$12 billion.
